Samuel Deacon, 1794, George III repeating table clock,

Samuel Deacon, 1794, George III repeating table clock, arched painted dial signed Deacon FECIT with floral spandrels and single key-wind, the lunette with a mechanised landscape scene, pull quarter repeat movement, striking on three bells, inlaid mahogany case with a casket hood, on splayed bracket feet, 55cm.

The case is generally in fair condition, sound but with some losses to the crossbanded decoration throughout, the beading to the top of the arch on the left side, beading around the glazing on the rear door. The movement and dial are original to the case with no evident modifications, perhaps the hands are later, the clock winds and ticks and the automaton action works, the repeat function works, there is a winding key which looks to be original. The clock is consigned by a local private client who bought the clock at auction in 1991, no further provenance is available.
