Score keeper

Good condition, enamel is good with minimal wear, no chips, metal badge is sound, a little worn around the extremities but no splits or dents, the top and bottom petal perhaps slightly bent, pin present and hinge working, stamped on the back Vaughton BIRMM.

Time keeper

Generally good condition, the enamel has some small scratches bit no large chips/losses, some wear to the extremities, again the top and bottom petals perhaps slightly bent, pin and hinge ok, stamped on the back Vaughton BIRMM.
