A silver pair case pocket watch, the white enamel centre to the dial covered by a bulls eye glass having a Roman numeral chapter ring and surrounded by a rural scenic border depicting a fisherman, flock of sheep and couple in period costume, in plain polished outer and inner cases, both cases hallmarked Birmingham 1786, key wind fusee movement numbered 1026, named Thomas Stripling Lichfield, diameter of dial 36mm, outer case 50mm, no personal monograms or inscriptions, watch is running at present time although no guarantee is given, watch is sold with a key.
