A fine Edwardian mahogany longcase clock,

A fine Edwardian mahogany longcase clock, case with three urn finials, pierced and carved broken swan-neck pediment, hood with acanthus scrolls, body with glazed panels, door with glazing bars, carved column supports, plain carving to the base, ogee bracket feet, thirteen inch arched silvered and brass dial, chapter ring with Roman numerals, subsidiary seconds dial, Westminster Whittingham and chime silent dials, signed J W Benson, London, triple weight eight-day movement with mercury compensated pendulum, striking on nine tubular gongs, height 252cm, width 59cm depth 45cm.

Fretwork to the hood damaged with rudimentary repairs, chip to right carved scrolls to the hood, side fretwork panels are good, glass in hood door is good, dial has some wear to the chapter and indicator rings, movement appears to be complete and all bells present, three weights present, mercury pendulum present and good, glass in the case and door is good, some old repairs to the fretwork on the door, fretwork panel to the back inside of the case is damaged with significant losses, base and feet are good with only some light scuffs.
