Condition Report

The suite is in very good overall condition, without any signs of rot and only very minor repairs. All chairs and the table itself are still sound in their frames, with only a small degree of movement, and some of the slats have a little movement. No evident replacement stretchers or slats. The repairs include one seat with a screw inserted in the place of one of the dowels. The undershelf joining the table supports has a split along the width but appears stable. Two of the chairs are missing one of the arched "spandrels" to the leg at the front of the seat. The present owners were advised not to treat the teak, and so instead had a well-fitted weatherproof cover made and is sold with the lot.
